Essay/Video Contest

WHO:

Any local high school student is eligible to submit an essay!

WHAT:

Write a 500-800 word essay or make a 2-3 minute video about a woman who has profoundly impacted your life. Feel free to choose a woman directly involved in your life or someone whose work or life has directly influenced you, even if you've never met them.

Written entries will be judged on originality, interest, vocabulary and grammar. Video entries will be judged on originality of work, creativity, and clarity of message. Entries cannot have been previously published or submitted. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.

WHEN:

Deadline for submission is January 19, 2018.

Mailed submissions must be postmarked no later than January 19, 2018.
